## Opening Times – House & Garden

Mid May to end of September: Wednesdays & Sundays. In addition May and August Bank Holidays – 1pm to 5pm (last admission 4pm). Garden only on Easter Monday. The Church of St James is open from Easter Sunday - 31st October each Wednesday, Saturday, Sunday and Bank holidays.

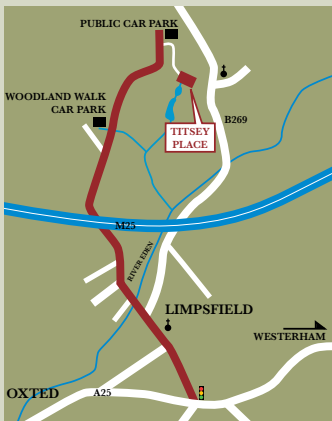

## Directions

From the A25 from Oxted to Westerham, turn down Limpsfield High Street. Turn left at the bottom on the sharp right hand bend into Bluehouse Lane. Then first right into Water Lane. Pass under the M25 and turn right at Pitchfont Lodge. Follow the signs to the Car Park by the Walled Garden.
